Legal requirements for professional Physical Therapy practice.

- **Physical Therapists must pass a qualifying examination to be licensed by the Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC).**
- **Verification of licensure is sent directly to FCCPT by the PRC.**
- **Philippine citizenship is required to obtain a Philippine License.**
