

Changes to College Level Examination Program® ACE Credit Recommendation

As of October 1, 2015, the American Council on Education (ACE) Credit Recommendations for College Level Examination Program® (CLEP) changed. FCCPT follows the recommendation by the ACE and therefore have updated our CLEP credit policy to follow the new recommendations.

CLEP exams taken **AFTER** October 1, 2015 will be awarded credit based on the updated ACE Credit recommendations (see link below for credit recommendations).

CLEP exams taken **BEFORE** October 1, 2015 will be awarded credit based on the ACE credit recommendations in place at the time of the examination.

The amount of credit awarded is determined by the date of the examination and not the date the official transcript is received at FCCPT.

The minimum passing score of 50 remains unchanged.
